The IEEE PDF eXpress service is used to assist authors in:

- a. converting their source files to PDF files that meet IEEE Xplore PDF compliance criteria, or
- b. checking if PDF files generated by authors meet IEEE Xplore PDF compliance criteria.

Before submitting your paper to the conference paper management system, please make sure that your PDF copy is IEEE Xplore compatible. This is mandatory for all manuscripts that have to be included in IEEE Xplore. If you use PDF eXpress to convert a source file to PDF, please note that PDF eXpress only creates the PDF file for you, and you should still submit the converted file to the conference paper management system.

Once you have prepared your manuscript, please follow the steps outlined below to use IEEE PDF eXpress:

1. Create an IEEE PDF eXpress account at <http://www.pdf-express.org> , use Conference ID: isot10x

[Notice: You will receive an email confirmation of your account. The email will indicate that *"The submission deadline for isot10x is Sunday, September 5, 2010."* That deadline is actually the **final camera-ready paper submission deadline** and should not be confused with the **initial paper submission deadline** of July 31, 2010. IEEE PDF eXpress should be used for **both** the **initial paper submission** as well as the **final camera-ready paper submission**]

2. You can either

- a. **Upload source file(s) for conversion to PDF using IEEE PDF eXpress.** In this case, a PDF version of the source file will be created and checked to see if it meets IEEE Xplore PDF compliance criteria. You will receive a first email confirming that you have submitted a source file to PDF eXpress, and a second email with a converted PDF file, if the generated PDF file does not violate IEEE Xplore PDF compliance criteria. In the case where the generated PDF file violates IEEE Xplore PDF compliance criteria, the second email comes with a report describing those violations. Any errors in the PDF eXpress report should be fixed and the file checked again by PDF eXpress before the paper is submitted to the conference.

Or

- b. **Upload a PDF file that you created yourself to check using IEEE PDF eXpress.** You will receive a first email confirming that you have submitted a PDF file to PDF eXpress, and a second email indicating whether the submitted PDF file meets IEEE Xplore requirements for PDF files or not. In the case

where the submitted PDF file violates IEEE Xplore requirements for PDF files, the second email comes with a report describing those violations. Any errors in the PDF eXpress report should be fixed and the file checked again by PDF eXpress before the paper is submitted to the conference.

[In either case, you will notice on the page where you upload the file a message “*After using IEEE PDF eXpress, submit your IEEE Xplore®-compatible PDF by 9/5/2010 <http://www.isot-2010.org>”*. The deadline there also refers to the final camera-ready paper submission deadline and not to the initial paper submission deadline of July 31, 2010. IEEE PDF eXpress should be used for **both** the **initial paper submission** as well as the **final camera-ready paper submission**]
