

Information regarding requests for visa assistance

ISOT 2010 organizers will provide visa letters to the conference attendees who have paid their registration fee in full.

Attendees are advised to contact the respective embassy before applying for a visa to find out which additional documents might be required. Due to the increased level of scrutiny for granting visas in the past period, conference attendees are advised to apply for a visa no later than 3 months prior to the conference.

Note that the conference organizer will not be able to negotiate the visa issue with an embassy or consulate on your behalf.

To request a visa letter please provide the following information:

- Full name (as it appears in your passport)
- Address
- E-mail
- Phone number
- Date of birth
- Passport number
- Affiliation (University/ Company)
- Are you a presenter/committee member/speaker at the conference
- If you present a paper, specify the paper title and list of authors
- Fax number (if you wish the request letter to be faxed)
- Address of the Embassy (if the letter needs to be mailed to the Embassy)
- The acknowledgment of paid conference registration fee(s)
